


### **EQUINE THERAPY PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN WITH ASD**

### Baix Llobregat With ISTEA Association

For the fourth consecutive year we finance this project together with the Istea Association, created and endorsed by a group of psychologists specializing in ASD who work voluntarily with them. Our work consists of supporting the demand of families with children with ASD, promoting knowledge and participation.

This program takes place during the 2023-2024 school year with 1.020 equine therapy sessions with recreational activities that allow the integration of children, in order to provide them with tools that allow positive development. This year, 60 children between 3 and 14 years old who suffer from autism spectrum disorder have enrolled in this program.

Many of the families with young people affected by this type of disorder are in a precarious situation and without sufficient resources to be able to offer them special education.

### PROVIDING FOOD TO THE SOLIDARITY COMMISSARY

#### Barcelona

#### With Roure Foundation

The Roure Foundation is an entity rooted in the old town of Barcelona, which serves the basic needs of older people and families. It provides comprehensive personalized attention to each member, so that they can be autonomous.

Social Services is still unable to supply the required food donations due to the number of families in precarious situations, whether single-parent, families with both spouses unemployed or without work.

During 2023 we have supported this program for the sixth time by purchasing dairy products, thus ensuring the continuity of the Solidarity Commissary to benefit 418 children between 0 and 16 years old.

### **SOCIAL CARE FOR CHILDREN FROM SINGLE-MOTHER FAMILIES**

### Barcelona

#### With Teresa Gallifa Foundation

The Teresa Gallifa Foundation works for the social inclusion of pregnant women and single-parent families, so that these mothers can enjoy motherhood with the support they need. Some women come from situations of violence and require comprehensive support, both legal and emotional advice, and cannot bear the costs of basic goods such as diapers, clothing or milk.

For the fourth consecutive year we collaborate on this project where the basic needs of 87 children under 6 years of age in extreme vulnerable situations will be covered. The aid consists of infant milk, cereals and baby food, diapers, hygiene products, and vaccines not included in Social Security but recommended by the Spanish Paediatric Association.


### **NUTRITION AND EDUCATION OF SHEPHERD CHILDREN**

### Kenya

### With Africa Digna Foundation

We continue to collaborate with the fifth program "Lchekuti, shepherd children" in Kenya together with Africa Digna Foundation. This project promotes a dignified life for 133 children aged 6 to 16 years by carrying out impactful educational and nutritional interventions in the Samburu communities of Barsaloi, Lodokume, Lowa and Lulu. They have access to two hours of education a day from Monday to Friday and a balanced meal at the end of classes each day.

For these communities, which are located in northern Kenya, pastoralism is their main economic activity. Because these little shepherd children work all day, they do not have the opportunity to go to school and are fed exclusively on milk and tea. Therefore, they are children who do not know how to read or write, with a high risk of social exclusion and with a considerable degree of malnutrition.

### With Kakrigu Primary School

Kakrigu Primary School is located on and examples of the second of the s

On November 9, 2022, there was a storm as well as the wiring of the affected classes. that caused serious damage to the school's infrastructure. Due to falling trees, 2 classes

and electrical wiring were destroyed. They temporarily used the library as a class and the other class was held under the remaining trees.

This project financed the material and reconstruction of the school's infrastructure, as well as the wiring of the affected classes.

### **NUTRITION PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN AND NURSING MOTHERS**

Kenya

#### With Aztivate Association

This project with Aztivate Association guaranteed that children from 0 to 6 years old and nursing mothers had access to comprehensive medical care for the prevention and treatment of malnutrition and other diseases, reducing mortality of both mothers and children in North Turkana County and Kenya's border area with South Sudan and Ethiopia.

The Nuria García Foundation has financed the medical care of 400 children and nursing women in the clinic and mobile unit, as well as the monitoring of cases, the purchase and distribution of therapeutic foods, training workshops for mothers and fathers on action protocols, and cultural patterns for better health and nutrition.

### **FOOD AND NUTRITION PROGRAM AT KIKAYA HOUSE**

### Uganda

### With Babies Uganda Association

The Babies Uganda Association collaborates to solve the dramatic reality that thousands of Ugandan children experience due to broken families, abandonment, death of their parents, abuse, or illness. In addition, they help progress and development throughout the community, especially in education and health.

Kikaya House is an orphanage that currently has 30 foster children and 6 caregivers who

take care of them. Also, part of the house are 3 workers in charge of the maintenance and security of the entire facility.

In this sixth project with Babies Uganda, we have financed the entire nutritious diet of the 30 children and the 9 caregivers for a year.



### With Babies Uganda Association

In Uganda functional diversity is a controversial issue. Furthermore, they do not have social aid or adequate treatment.

The CEVIC school is responsible for the medical care, nutrition and education of 50 children with visual disabilities. Most of these children's families live in remote areas, so the school not only provides them with essential food and care, but also muchneeded stability.

The Nuria García Foundation, with the collaboration of Tailored Perfumes, has once again financed the school fees of the 50 children during the 2023 school year. This includes their schooling, dormitory, food and medical care expenses.


### Senegal

### With Guné Foundation

Since 2016 we have collaborated with the Guné Foundation to improve the quality of life of thousands of children in vulnerable situations in Senegal. The population of the Soussoutou village lives in a savanna area, far from urban centres, surrounded by pasture areas and without a road network that facilitates the movement of its population to health or educational centres. The town is located 40 kilometres from the nearest city.

With our support, since 2020, 5 classrooms and bathrooms have already been built at the Soussoutou school. However, there are still classes made from straw and reed.

This year we have once again financed a new cement classroom in this village to improve the study conditions of 229 children.

### **IMPROVING THE GAMBASSE SCHOOL**

### Guinea-Bissau With SILO Association

SILO Association has been collaborating in Guinea-Bissau, one of the most underdeveloped countries in the world, for almost 20 years. They promote the development of rural communities, and intervene to promote education, access to health and improvements in nutrition.

In this fifth collaboration we have once again improved the education of more than 900 children at the Gambasse school.

We have financed the acquisition of books, prints, school supplies, and computers, as well as scholarships for 5 children and contributed to the salaries of the 30 teachers. In addition, we have financed the salary of the staff and the maintenance of the Gambasse medical clinic, to improve the precarious health conditions of the children's population.


### FIGHT AGAINST MATERNAL AND CHILD MALNUTRITION

### Mozambique

With IBO Foundation

Food care at the IBO Nutritional Support Centre (CANI) helps children under 5 years of age who attend the nutritional program, where they receive enriched porridge that their mothers learn to cook with local products and that they can replicate at home. Milk is also distributed to beneficiary babies to treat malnutrition and mitigate caloric and nutritional deficiencies.

The average stay of each child in the nutritional program is three months and the mothers are involved in the project



In this third collaboration, we once again fight against maternal and child malnutrition of 350 children for 12 months. We want to contribute to the socioeconomic development of IBO and to the improvement of the precarious situation in which its inhabitants find themselves.

### **HEALTH AND NUTRITION PROGRAM**

#### Peru

#### With Amantaní Association

For 26 years, the Amantaní Association has focused its work on four homes that welcome and provide comprehensive care to babies, children and adolescents without family protection in Cusco.

State centres are very few, the reception of children in a situation of lack of family protection is an urgent need. Poverty accentuates the problems of gender violence, sexual abuse, abandonment, child abuse, maternal mortality, child labour, begging, addiction problems, etc.

Since 2019, the Nuria García Foundation has quaranteed health care for babies, children and adolescents housed in the Amantaní shelters in Cusco.

The funding covers paediatrician home visits, laboratory analyses and tests, consultations with specialists and hospitalizations, physical therapy, medications, oxygen, ophthalmology, glasses and dentistry, as well as the purchase of balanced food to care for 60 children.


### With Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos Foundation

During 2023 we conclude the collaboration in the Padre Wasson community family centre project, located in a conflictive area of Chimaltenango, which provides education, health, nutrition and training services to families without resources in the area.

A 3-story building that houses the family centre was rehabilitated and a multidisciplinary team of professionals specialized in psych pedagogy, physical and occupational therapy, youth and

community development has been hired, in which we have financed all the equipment.

The beneficiaries have been 300 highly vulnerable children, young people and single-parent families, who have received tutoring and school reinforcement services, reception, diagnosis, therapy and integration for children with disabilities, and psychosocial and professional development.

### CARE AND PROTECTION OF VULNERABLE CHILDREN

**Honduras** 

### With Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos Foundation

In this seventh collaboration with NPH, we have focused on the "Casa Mi Esperanza" (CME) transition home project, which was founded in 2017 to temporarily house children living at social risk in Olancho, Honduras.

Recently, the minors housed in the home have had to urgently move to new accommodation.

NPH Honduras has rented a new space, in the town of Sta. María del Real, where they will stay temporarily while waiting to build a new home suitable for their needs.

The Nuria García Foundation has financed the support, medical care, education and transportation services of 130 vulnerable children.

### **MOBILE MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH UNIT**

#### India

#### With Colours of Calcutta Foundation

conditions in the Pilkhana neighbourhood in Calcutta are extremely harsh: precarious infrastructure, families living in shanties, in unsafe buildings with minimal substandard housing without light, On the other hand, the fixed health care without ventilation and without water.

In this fourth collaboration, we have financed the launch of two mobile maternal and child health units for 6 months. The project includes the salary of a doctor and a nursing person, care and nutrition for more than 150 children under 2 years of age and

150 mothers with nutritional deficiencies and anaemia, as well as medication, vaccines and diagnostic tests.

and nutrition unit for mothers and children at the Talapark clinic identifies and follows up on pregnant women and their babies. In addition to receiving specialized medical care, the beneficiary population has also received nutrition and hygiene kits and training sessions in health, parenting and family planning.

### PROMOTE FEMININE HYGIENE FOR GIRLS AND YOUTH

### Nepal

### With Bahadur Social Project

This 2023 we have joined forces with the Bahadur Social Project Association with the main objective of promoting children's and youth feminine hygiene in rural indigenous communities in the Gorkha district, Nepal.

The Nuria García Foundation is financing the distribution of feminine hygiene kits and school uniforms for 455 girls under 16 years of age in four primary and secondary schools, as well as training to deal with common health situations that will help them follow up on their education during

the menstruation. These kits will be delivered with the aim of improving girls' hygiene and will be accompanied by training. In turn, this improvement in their hygiene will encourage girls' school enrolment and attendance during menstruation. Each kit contains: hygienic material, reusable pads, underwear, hot water bottle (for pain during menstruation), thermometer, basic medications and school uniforms for the participants.

Created with love, Eau my BB is a range of solidarity products intended for the little ones. Since its launch in 2017, a percentage of sales is allocated to health and nutrition projects of children most in need with the Nuria García Foundation.

During 2023, a total of **51,745.96€** has been raised and has been allocated to: the social care program for children from single-parent families in Barcelona; feeding orphaned children at Kikaya House, Uganda; the maternal and child nutrition project in Mozambique; the health and nutrition program of the shelters in Cuzco, Peru and the mobile maternal and child health unit in Calcutta, India.







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


